<b>Request Description:</b>	<p>Project will construct single-story additions at two (2) wings of the existing Building 3723 child development center comprised of structural steel frame with reinforced concrete foundation and floor slab, structural frame, metal stud walls, split face architectural masonry veneer, stucco finish system and asphalt shingle roof. Exterior materials and finishes shall match existing facility exterior. All required furniture, fixtures, and equipment, to include intercom and closed circuit television equipment is included. A partial interior renovation of Building 3723 and required demolition of exterior elements required for the new additions is included in the project. Includes additional parking, access road, site preparation, utilities, and all other support work necessary to provide a complete and useful Child Development Center. All required outdoor activity areas, playground equipment and storage buildings are included.</p>
